# Revision to the 2023-2024 School Calendar

- On April 8, 2024, Northeast Ohio will experience a total solar eclipse
- The eclipse is expected to bring tens of thousands of visitors to Northeast Ohio. As the greater Cleveland area will be in the path of totality
- The Board of Education approved a revision to the 2023-2024 school calendar to extend spring break through Monday, April 8
- I recommended the calendar revision due to safety concerns

# School Resource Officer - Agreement

- On October 17, a memorandum of understanding between the FPCS Board of Education and the City of Fairview Park was approved to enter into an agreement to provide a School Resource Officer for the 2024-2025 school year.
- The SRO would be stationed at FHS/LMMS, but travel to the elementary schools as well
- An SRO brings specialized skills to help educate students and staff on a variety of topics: emergency preparedness, de-escalation techniques, digital safety, the threat of human trafficking, substance abuse, and mental health awareness.
- The Fairview Park City Council will meet tonight to consider the MOU

# Partnership to Conduct a Health Needs Assessment

- We have partnered with the Educational Service Center of Northeast Ohio and MetroHealth school-based health experts to develop a health needs assessment for students, staff, parents and community members. The focus of the survey is grades 6-12.
- The Project Prevent grant supports initiatives that address violence, trauma, anxiety and other mental health needs among our youth
- The needs assessment data will help the district identify gaps in mental health needs among our youth and work with county, local and internal stakeholders to create interconnect systems of mental health support

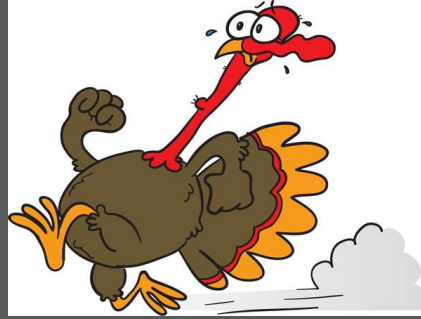

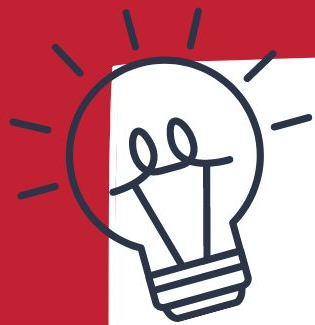
