See Your High School Guidance Counselor

- **Ask your counselor to submit a high school transcript to LCCC.** Ask your guidance counselor to include any ACT or SAT scores you may have on file.



Meet Statewide Eligibility Criteria or Remediation-free Standards

1. Students with at least a **3.0 unweighted cumulative high school GPA** are eligible for admission. *If you have a 2.75 unweighted cumulative high school GPA, contact an LCCC academic advisor to see if additional statewide flexibility guidance may still qualify you for admission.*

-OR-

2. Students without a high school GPA or GPA lower than 3.0 may still be eligible to participate in CCP by meeting remediation-free testing standards in at least one subject area.

** Please note colleges may have other course placement standards in addition to eligibility criteria to determine a student's eligibility to take certain courses. See your college advisor for details.*

Register for Classes

High School Site CCP courses will be scheduled by your high school counselors utilizing a batch registration just prior to the beginning of Fall and Spring Terms.

Students planning to take LCCC online or on campus courses should:

1. Meet with your high school guidance counselor to discuss options and ask your guidance counselor to submit an electronic course authorization form.
2. Visit www.lorainccc.edu/ccp for a list of level I CCP courses.
3. Visit www.lorainccc.edu/catalog to view course descriptions and pre-requisites using the link for "Course Descriptions" in the lower left.
4. Search the LCCC Class Schedule, available at www.lorainccc.edu under the "Academics" menu, to view course availability.
5. **Contact your LCCC Academic advisor to complete the registration process for your courses.** View your assigned advisor checking your MyCampus account Student Center. Check www.lorainccc.edu for contact information and available appointments.
